

## Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary – August 22

On August 22, the Church celebrates the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a feast that honors Mary's special role as Queen of Heaven and Earth. Following her Assumption into Heaven, Mary was crowned by her Son, Jesus Christ, not as a ruler of worldly power, but as a mother who lovingly intercedes for her children. Her queenship reflects her unique place in salvation history, chosen by God to bring the Savior into the world and to guide His followers to Him.

This day is an opportunity for us to turn to Mary as our spiritual mother—seeking her prayers, imitating her faith, and trusting in her care. Just as a good mother listens to her children, Mary listens to us and brings our needs to her Son. As we honor her, we remember that her greatest desire is to lead us closer to Jesus, the true King.

**Prayer:** *Mother and Queen of Heaven, this day I run to you as a child with confidence and trust. You are the glorious Queen Mother, reigning over all of your children with love and mercy. Please pray for me, and bestow upon me all that I need. I open my heart to the grace of your Son, which you are entrusted to dispense. Make me holy and free from sin, so you can present me spotless and pure to your beloved Son, the King of the Universe. Queen of Heaven, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You.*



## An Evening of Conversation for Parents with Bishop Johnston on The Way

Bishop Johnston invites all parents of the diocese to join him, along with staff from the Office of Domestic Church & Discipleship, for an opportunity to discuss the elements of our diocesan vision known as The Way: Youth to Young Adult Initiative (learn more at [www.kcsjatholic.org/theway](http://www.kcsjatholic.org/theway)).

Raising children in the faith is a challenge, and the Church wants to help! This event is a unique opportunity to share directly with Bishop the needs of your family and ways your local church can support you. The evening begins with a presentation addressing the goals outlined in the Diocesan Vision, including the establishment of a camp and retreat center. This will be followed by a Listening Session for parents to share their thoughts and questions. There are eight opportunities to participate in this conversation across all six deaneries of the diocese.

The session scheduled for your area of the diocese (Deanery VI) is Monday, September 29<sup>th</sup> at Holy Rosary Parish: 610 S. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Clinton.

All sessions will begin at 6:30 pm and will conclude at 8:00 pm.
