



Catholic Corner

On September 14, we not only celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, but also the birthday of Pope St. Leo the Great, one of the most important leaders of the early Church. Serving as pope in the 5th century, St. Leo is remembered for his wisdom, courage, and devotion to protecting the truth of our Catholic faith. His powerful sermons helped Christians better understand the mystery of Christ, and his writings continue to inspire the Church today.

Pope St. Leo faced many challenges during his papacy, including times of uncertainty and division, yet he remained a strong shepherd who trusted completely in God's guidance. He reminded the faithful that true strength and victory are found in the Cross of Christ. As families, we can learn from his example by turning to prayer in difficult times, standing firm in our faith, and teaching our children that God's love and truth will always endure.

Family Activity:

This week, place a small cross in a central spot in your home—on the kitchen table or family prayer corner. As a family, take a moment each day to look at the cross and say together: "We adore You, O Christ, and we bless You, because by Your Holy Cross You have redeemed the world." Talk with your children about one way they can "carry the cross" in their own lives—such as being kind when it's hard, forgiving someone, or helping without being asked.



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
